(ii) Request to arrange Lift & Escalators

Response:

As per Railway Board's policy guidelines, minimum required footfall for provision of Escalator at station is 25,000 per day. Hence Tirunelveli Jn., only eligible for provision of Escalators in this constituency. At present Two Escalators and Two lifts are available in Tirunelveli Station and one No. of Lift installation under progress. Further provision of Lifts will be done based on Techno- Economic feasibility for the Railway Stations in this constituency.

There are around 19 Railway Stations situated in Tirunelveli Parliamentary Constituency. All the Stations have been provided with Minimum Essential Amenities as per Board's norms, except to the following items indicated against each Station.

Response: The rake of T.No.16791/16792 Tirunelveli Palakkad Palaruvi Express undergoes primarily maintenance at Tirunelveli. Hence extension of this train to Tuticorin is not feasible.
Request to extend 'Lokmanya Tilak Express' (Train No.11043/11044) upto Tuticorin
Response: T. No. 11043/11044 (New No. 22101 / 22102) Lokamanya Tilak Terminus - Madurai (Wkly) Express is the only train originating from Madurai for Mumbai. As per the occupancy data taken prior to the pandemic, this train showed utilization of berth to be as high as 122%. Extension of this train to Tuticorin will result in the reduction in availability of berths for the existing users of this facility.
However, T. No. 19567/19568 Tuticorin-Okha (Weekly) Express provides connectivity from Tuticorin to Mumbai area.
Request to introduce New Express train between Chennai and Thoothukudi.
Response: Due to terminal constraints at Chennai Egmore, it is not feasible to introduce new trains between Chennai Egmore and Tuticorin.
Request for stoppage of Tiruchendur Express at AlwarThirunagari
Response: Five pairs of passenger trains running in Tirunelveli-Tiruchendur section and one pair of Express train viz T. No. 16731/16732 Pollachi-Tiruchendur-Pollachi Express have been provided stoppage at AlwarTirunagari station. T.No.16105/16106 Chennai Egmore - Tiruchendur Express is stopping at Srivaikundam and Nazareth stations which are only 4.9 kms and 5.7 kms away from AlwarTirunagari respectively

5.0 Extension and provision of stoppage of Train No.16352 & 16351 (Mumbai-Nagercoil Express) at Tirupati

Response:

T.No. 16351/16352 Mumbai CST – Nagercoil Bi-Weekly Express was routed via Renigunta without touching Tirupati to avoid back tracking (from Renigunta to Tirupati and back to Renigunta) and loco reversals at Renigunta and Tirupati which were time consuming and delaying the train.

Renigunta is only 10kms from Tirupati and is conveniently connected by road and rail.

6.0 Request for increasing the height of platform and extension of platform for 21 coaches in Kayalpattinam Railway Station

Response:

Kayalpattinam (flag) is an 'NSG6' category station on Tirunelveli—Tiruchendur section of Madurai Division. The existing platform No. 1 is at medium level having 405 m length to hold the longest stopping train scheduled to stop at this station. Hence, as far as length of PF is concerned, no extension is required.

With respect to Raising of Platform to high level, it is submitted that all the existing Rail and Medium Level PFs at higher category stations viz., 'NSG1 to NSG4' are proposed to be raised to High Level in a Phased Manner as per availability of sanction and funds. Raising of PFs to High Level at important Stations is also done. Hence, raising platform level at 'NSG5 to NSG6' category stations as well as Halt Stations will be taken up only after completion of raising of PFs at NSG1 to NSG4 categories (higher categories).

At present, no sanction available for the work of Raising of Platform to High Level at Kayalpattinam station.

7.0 Request for restoring the earlier arrangement of Connecting Link Trains from Thoothukkudi to Guruvayur Express and Nagercoil Express, rather than having a separate train for the purpose.

Response:

Link trains have been discontinued on the advise of Railway Board in the interest of safety. Further, Trains have been suitably scheduled to provide connectivity between Tuticorin and Vanchi Maniyachchi for the passengers travelling by Nagercoil - Coimbatore Express (T.No 22668/67 NCJ-CBE-NCJ Exp) and Chennai -Guruvayur Express

Further T.No 12693/94 Pearl City Express provides connectivity between Tuticorin and Chennai.

	Response: Stoppages at Kadambur and VanchiManiyachchi for T. No. 06723/06724 Chennai Egmore - Kollam – Chennai Egmore (Daily) Special has been withdrawn due to poor patronage.
9.0	Request to construct a underpass for the for free vehicle movement
	(i) From Kovilpatti Lakshmi Mills gate to Ilayarasanendal Railway Board at Inam Maniyachi
	Response: A subway has already been provided at Railway Km 588/800-900 in lieu of LC No.440 at Kovipatti Lakshmi Mills gate to Ilayarasanendal Railway Road at Inam Maniyachi
	(ii) Dakshinamoorthy Street Railway line

Hence, there is no justification for having reservation counter at Rajagambiram. Nearest reservation facility is available at Manamadurai (5.7 Kms)

Platfrom Shelter:

Rajagambiram is a halt station under HG3 category station. No platform shelter is required as per the norms.

Rajagambiram (halt) is a HG3 category station where passenger foot fall varies from 0 to 44. Hence this station does not qualify for provision of platform shelters.

13.0 Request to put into practice of Reservation Counter permanently at Manamadurai Junction

Response:

Manamadurai is already provided with I-UTS facility to proliferate both reserved and unreserved tickets at the same place.

14.0 Request for construction of subway between Manamadurai town to 4way road near Railway station

Response:

The request for RUB is in lieu of Existing LC No.34 at Railway km 47/200-300 in between Tiruchchirappalli and Manamadurai Railway Stations in Madurai Division. Chief Engineer (Highways) / Projects wing D.O. Letter No. 1524/W2/2019, dated 12.09.2019 stated that this LC is not feasible for construction of ROB/RUB as per following reasons.

"This LC having three tracks in curve. One PWD supply canal runs along the right side of the road.
