Special Train from Pune to Hazrat Nizamuddin - Bookings open on 27.5.2018

Central Railway ahs decided to run one Superfast Special train on special charges from Pune to Hazrat Nizamuddin to clear the extra rush of passengers on 29.5.2018. The details are as under:

Train No. 02099 Superfast Special will leave Pune at 00.25 hrs on 29.05.2018 (mid- night of 28/29.5.2018) and will arrive Hazrat Nizamuddin at 02.00 hrs next day.

Halts: Chinchwad, Lonavala, Panvel, Vasai Road, Surat, Vadodara, Godhra, Ratlam, Nagda, Kota, Sawai Madhopur, Mathura and Palwal.

Composition: one AC-2 Tier, one AC-3 Tier, 9 Sleeper class, 2 Second class seating and 7 General second class.

Reservation: Bookings for 02099 Special Train on special charges will open on27.05.2018 at all PRS centers and on website www.irctc.co.in. The general second class coaches and second class seating coaches of these trains will run as unreserved coaches and bookings will be done through unreserved ticketing system (UTS).
